African Mutual Assistance Association of Missouri Receives \$50,000 Grant Missouri Foundation for Health Grant Helps with Medical Transportation and Interpreter Services.

The African Mutual Assistance Association of Missouri (AMAAM) Board of Directors has received a two year grant of \$50,000 (\$25,000 per year) from the Missouri Foundation for Health.
